

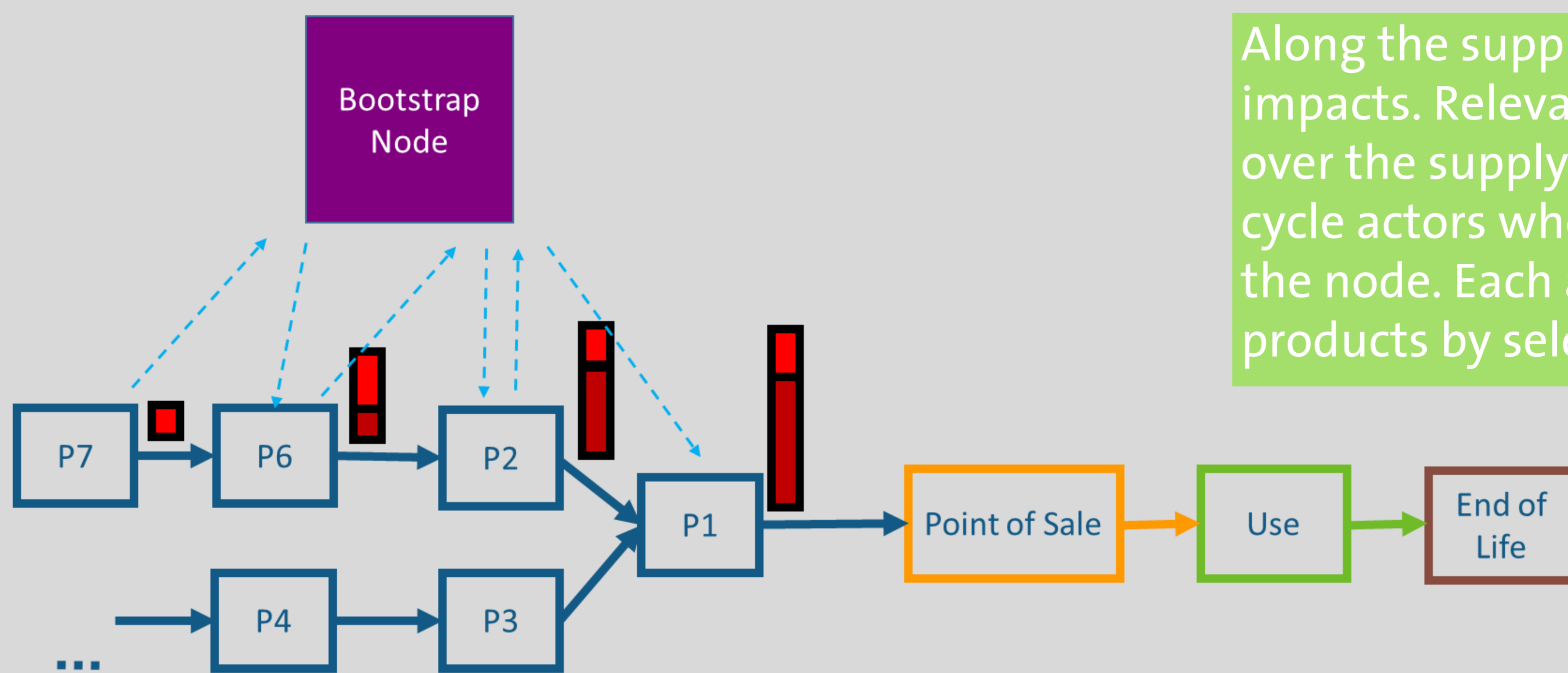
# SuBoot – Sustainability Bootstrap project: the first implementation

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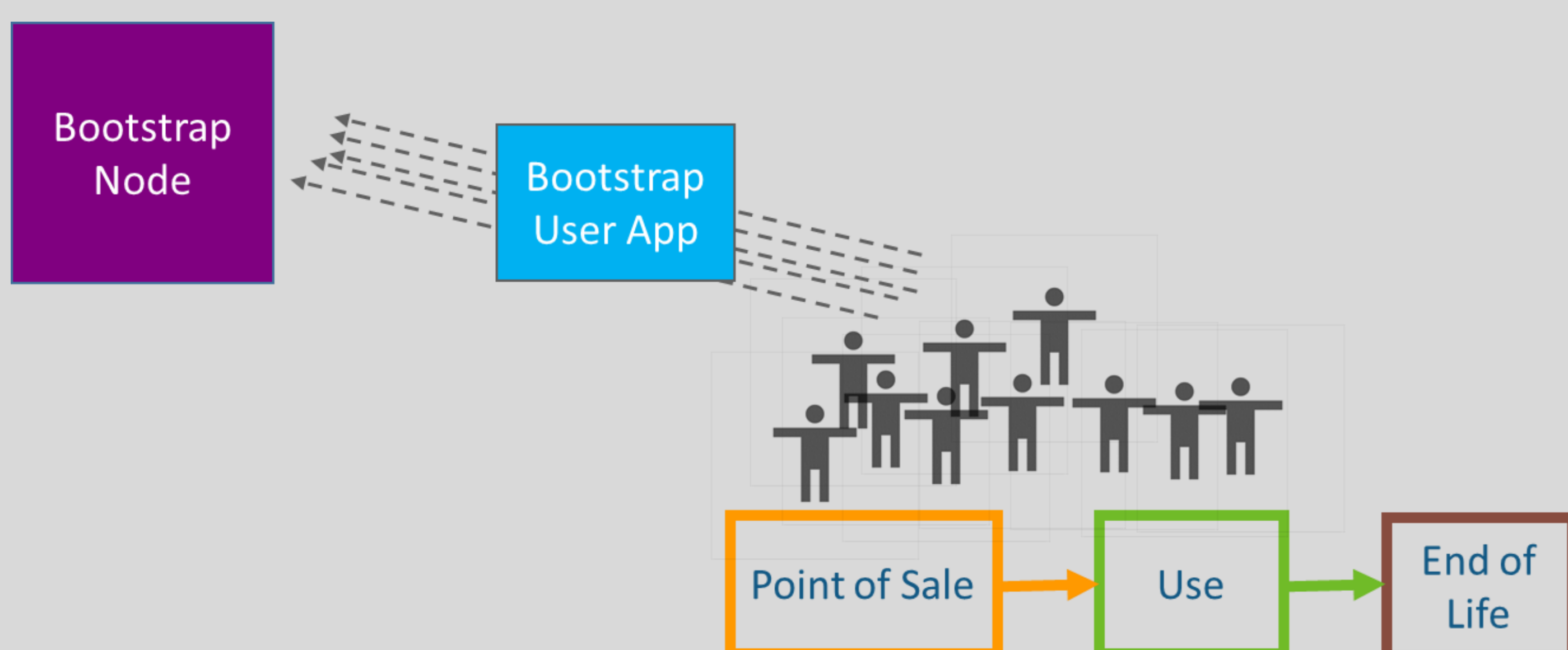
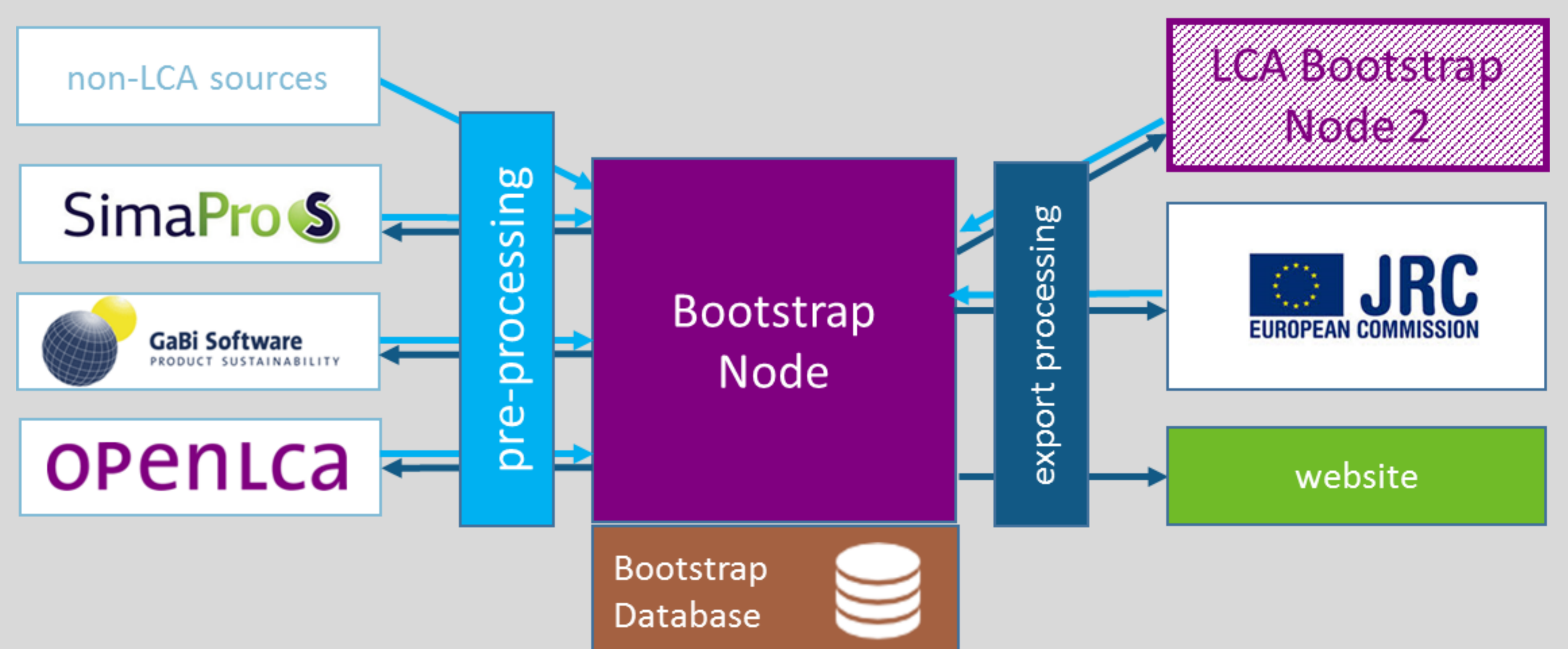
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The SuBoot project will drastically increase the availability of sustainability data over the life cycle of products, by establishing incentives for data owners to publish data, and by establishing a technical infrastructure able to handle this information.



Along the supply chain, each process P contributes specific impacts. Relevant for an assessment are the sum of impacts over the supply chain. In SuBoot, a node interacts with life cycle actors who upload own data, and find data through the node. Each actor can influence the impact of own products by selecting products with lower impacts.

Each node is able to read from LCA software, interact with other nodes, and to display data on a website; it interacts with an app.



End users have access to data on each node, and supply feedback related to products. They use the information for purchase decisions, and thereby decide over supply chains.

A first pilot is currently implemented in Sweden, in the food and retailer sector. A pilot for the textile industry is in preparation.
